


DESIGN PROCESS

(1) form building according to sun path and wind pattern to alleviate solar exposure / heat in most habited spaces and to maximize light, cross ventilation and passive cooling

(2) consider users and activities. apply building code and village association restrictions and allow for open space expansion, and vegetation. adapt to taste and preference of client.


(3) treat for sustainable building use, dynamic, and aesthetic accordingly.


The small village is relatively cool during the day due to the presence of much vegetation, although potential for urban sprawl is felt, thus the need for a larger allocated space for planters and vegetation within the lot.















ROAD RIGHT OF WAY






stair detail with powder room (sliding door); possible patio/storage underneath


